HAUS Scholarship for American Undergraduate or Masters Students at Heidelberg University in Heidelberg, Germany



Heidelberg Alumni U.S. (HAUS) is pleased to invite applications for the HAUS Scholarship. The stipend is available to a qualified student from the United States to study at Universität Heidelberg. The scholarship award is \$5,000 per semester for Masters program students and \$3,000 for Bachelors program students. Scholarship recipients may re-apply for a subsequent semester. We are seeking candidates with a strong academic background who can also fulfill the role of ambassador for Heidelberg Alumni U.S. upon their return from their study abroad experience.

Universität Heidelberg is consistently ranked as one of the best universities in Germany and one of the top rated institutes of higher education and research in the world. It has been distinguished twice as an elite university in the framework for the German Excellence Initiative. Heidelberg University is a research university with a wide range of study programs and a strong international orientation: roughly one-fifth of the university's 33,000 students and one-third of doctoral candidates are foreign nationals.

With its landmark castle, Old Town and the river Neckar, Heidelberg is considered to be one of the most beautiful cities in Germany. It is conveniently located just one hour south of Frankfurt airport.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Minimum qualifications:

1. Undergraduate or Masters program student at an institution of higher education in the U.S.
2. United States Residency
3. Admission as student at Universität Heidelberg (proof can be submitted at a later time)

Scholarship Recipient Expectations:

1. Cooperate with Heidelberg Alumni International (HAI) while in Heidelberg
2. Serve as ambassador for Heidelberg Alumni U.S. and Universität Heidelberg after completing his/her studies in Heidelberg.

Application process:

1. Complete the HAUS Scholarship application form (all subjects required)
2. Submit an essay describing your interest in and qualifications for the scholarship and explain why you would like to study at Heidelberg University and your special interests (500-600 words)
3. Submit the latest transcript (electronically)
4. Submit a recommendation letter by your professor
5. Submit proof of U.S. residency (copy of driver's license, utility bill, U.S. passport, etc.)
6. Short-listed candidates will participate in an oral interview.

. Additional travel grants might be available through the Max Kade Foundation. HAUS will not support students who received another stipend for their stay in Heidelberg.
